

WEST EDMONTON - PRECIOUS GREEN SPACES

This delightful walk provides the reward of a magnificent panorama of the valley and Quesnell Bridge. In winter the steep bank south of the Campbell Bridge (Fox Drive) is a popular sledding destination.

TRAILHEAD: *Whitemud Ravine Nature Reserve north parking lot*

DISTANCE/DIFFICULTY: *3 km round trip (6 km round trip if you start at the John Janzen Nature Centre); moderate, not universal access Granular trail with one moderate hill and a short flight of stairs before the top of the bank.*

- The beginning of the trail is partially hidden by trees. It starts out east of the big hill parallel to Fox Drive.
- From the Whitemud Ravine Nature Reserve parking lot, walk east, behind the A.H. Savage amenity

building, below the big hill to the granular path that enters the woods. The trail has a gradual slope, and at the fork there is a sign that says Grandview Drive West/125 Street.

- Turn right to Grandview Drive West and continue up the hill to a set of stairs with 50 easy steps to the top of the bank. Enjoy the view.
- You may go down the steep stairs or complete the loop by walking east along Grandview Drive on the grass path just west of 125 Street.
- On your left is an opening in the trees and a path leading downhill through the woods. Turn left on the path parallel to Fox Drive and return to the parking lot.
